**Health Statement:**

The undersigned, official veterinarian, declares that the birds described above meet the following requirements.

1. The birds were examined within 24 hours prior to shipment; during that examination no symptoms of disease were evident.
2. The birds have been sent from premises where no case of Fowl Plaque (Avian Influenza) has been diagnosed during the 30 days prior to shipment.
3. The birds came from premises, or from an area with a radius of 20 kms, with no restrictions regarding Newcastle Disease.
4. The birds have / have not been vaccinated against Newcastle Disease.
5. The birds have remained for 30 days prior to shipment on premises where they have not been in contact with birds of the same species which do not meet the above mentioned conditions.
6. The birds have been sent in containers which are easy to clean and disinfect. The containers have been cleaned and disinfected with a registered disinfectant immediately before loading and dispatch.

This certificate is valid for 10 days from the date of shipment.
